

Vernham Dean Gillum's Primary Sports Premium Funding Allocation 2015-2016

What is the Primary Sport Premium Funding?

This is funding for primary schools and has been designed to help schools improve the quality of PE and sport activities they offer their pupils. Schools receive the sport premium funding based on the number of pupils in Year 1 through to 6. Each school with 17 or more eligible pupils will receive £8000 and an additional £5 per pupil to be spent on improving sport and PE provision for all pupils. But they are free to choose the best way of using the money.

'We are spending over £450 million on improving physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools over the 3 academic years 2013 to 2014, 2014 to 2015 and 2015 to 2016. We will allocate this extra funding directly to primary headteachers.'

Intended outcomes for our school's Sport Premium Funding:

- Improve the quality of teaching and learning in PE so that pupils make good progress in lessons over the unit/year
- Staff access to training opportunities and continuous professional development
- All pupils to benefit regardless of sporting ability
- Run sports activities with other schools
- Provide a lunchtime coach once a week to teach healthy dynamic exercise
- Provide a sports club that offers a range of sports in order to increase competitive sport and link with running sports activities with other clubs
